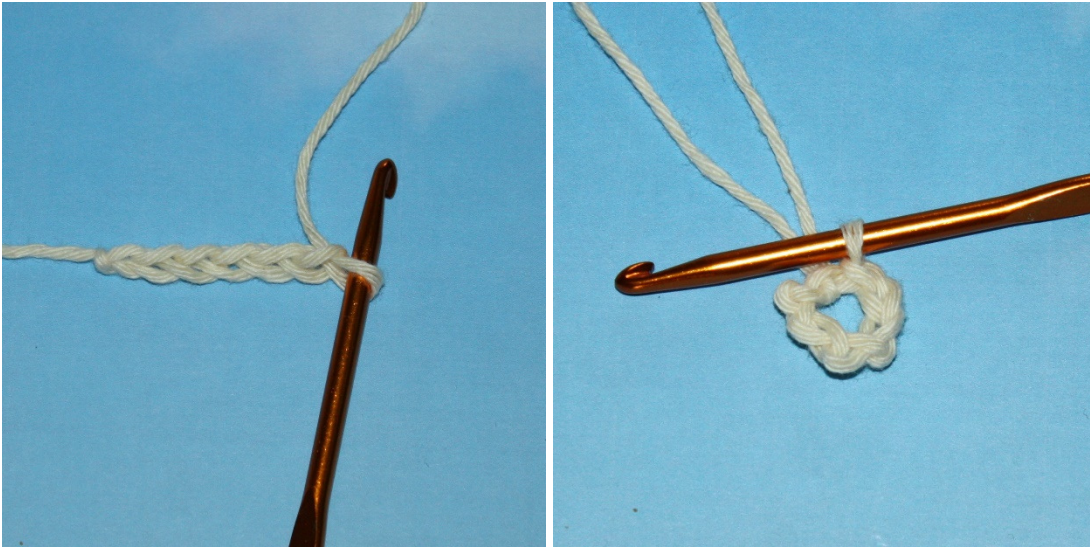


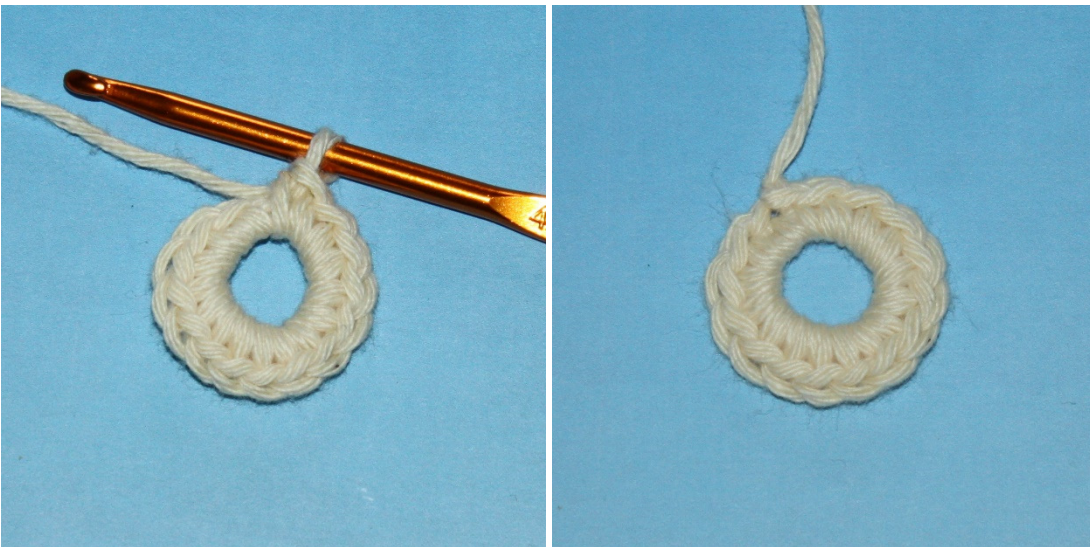
Daisy

Use colour A to make the centre sc ring

Chain 6. Slip stitch into first chain to make a ring.

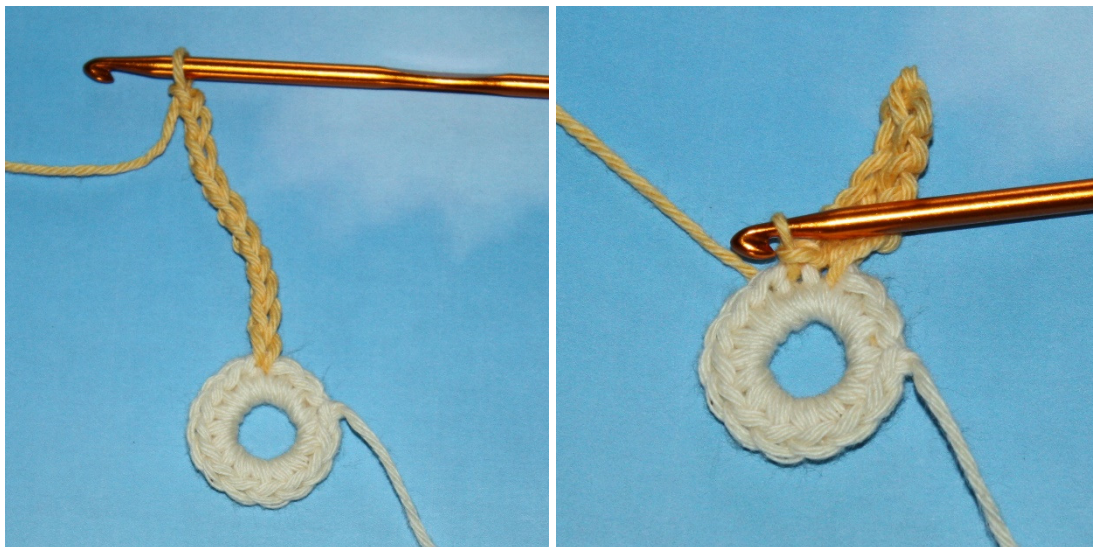


Single crochet 15 times into the ring. You may need to shunt the stitches along with your fingers to ensure that all 15 will fit into the ring. Join with a slip stitch into first single crochet and fasten off.

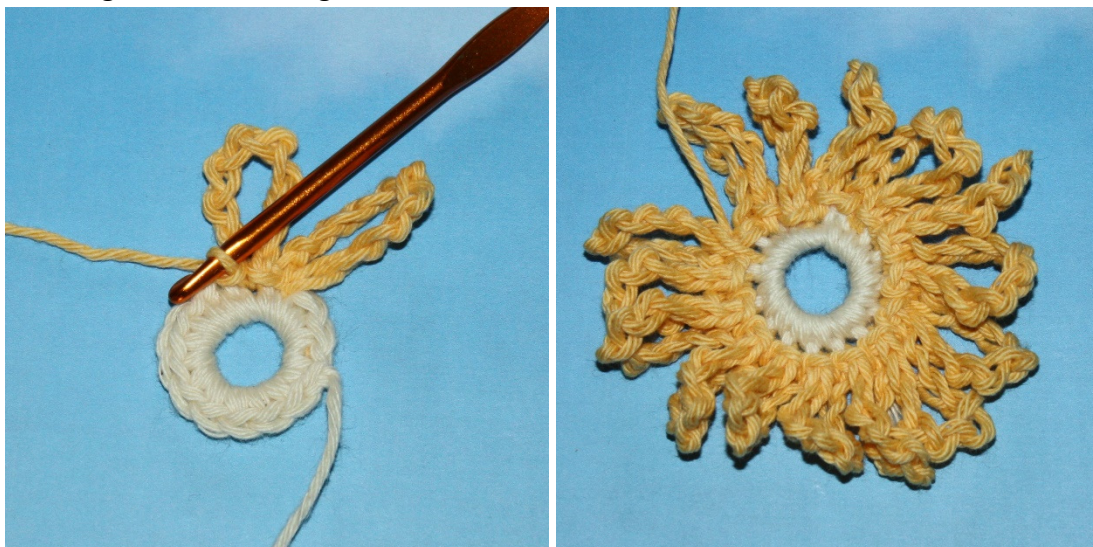


Use colour B to make the chain petals.

Join yarn with a slip stitch into any sc stitch. Chain 10 and secure by slip-stitching into the same stitch.



Slip stitch into next sc, chain 10 and secure the petal with a slip stitch in the same stitch. Continue in this way, slip stitching, chaining 10 and slip stitching to make each petal. You will have 15 in total. Finish by slip stitching into the starting sc. Fasten off.



Weave in all your ends and pull your petals into shape. For extra definition, you can pin your flower onto a folded towel, pinning out each petal and then spray with water and allow to dry.
