

# Retro Flower Granny Square

*US Crochet Terminology*



A crochet pattern by Merrian Holland

## Tools & Materials

### Yarn:

DK / 8ply / US 3 (Light) cotton yarn in 4 colours.

I have used [Ricorumi DK cotton](#) & [Paintbox Cotton DK](#)

### Hook:

[4mm/ F-G Hook](#)

### Finished dimensions:

10cm / 4" x10 cm/ 4"

Finished size & yardage will vary depending on hook size, yarn thickness & your personal gauge.

## Key (US terminology)

beg – beginning

BLO – back loop only

ch – chain

dc – double crochet

filled-Y stitch – see special stitches below

hdc – half double crochet

prev – previous

rnd - round

sc – single crochet

sk – skip

sl st – slip st

st(s) – stitch(es)

tr – treble crochet

### Sample Colours:

Rnd 1 – Ricorumi DK Cotton in Ivory

Rnd 2 - Ricorumi DK Cotton in Grey

Rnd 3 – Ricorumi DK Cotton in Papaya

Rnds 4 & 5 - Paintbox DK Cotton in Coffee Bean

## Special Stitches

Filled-Y st: make a tr, 3dc through the post of the tr, catching the two strands at the front, just below the midline of the st.

## Round 1

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With Colour A : 4ch and join in 1<sup>st</sup> ch with sl st to form a ring; 3ch (counts as 1dc); 15dc into the ring; cut yarn and join with sewn bind off.

**16sts**

## Round 2

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With Colour B : Join yarn in any st, 1ch and 1sc in the same st, (2sc in the next stitch, 1sc in the next) x 7, 2sc in the last stitch; finish with sewn bind off.

*24sts*

## Round 3

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With Colour C : Working BLO for the whole round, join yarn in any st; 1ch, sl st in the same stitch, \*(in the next stitch - sl st, 2ch, 1dc, 1tr, 1ch; in the next stitch – 1tr, 1dc, 2ch, sl st\*\*; sl st in the next stitch) x 7; repeat from \* to \*\* once more; join in 1st sl st with a sl st and fasten off.

*8 petals, with 1sl st between each*



## Round 4



With Colour D : Join yarn in BLO of any ch1 of a flower tip, 1ch, 1sc in the same st; [make a filled-Y\* st in the back loop of the sc of round two that contains the slip stitch between the two petals; 1ch; 1sc in the back loop of the ch1 sp at the tip of the next petal] x7; make a filled-Y\* st in the back loop of the sc of round two that contains the slip stitch between the two petals; 1ch; join with sl st in 1<sup>st</sup> sc of the rnd – do not fasten off.

*8x sc, 8x filled-Y st, 8x ch1*

\*see special stitches

## Round 5



Continuing with Colour D : 1ch, 1sc in the same st as sl st join from prev rnd; 1sc in next st; into next 3sts & ch1 sp make the following – [1hdc] x 2, [1dc] x2; \*in next st make corner – 1dc, 1tr, 2ch, 1tr, 1dc; into the next 11 sts and ch sps - [1dc] x 2, [1hdc] x2, [1sc] x3, [1hdc] x2, [1dc] x 2 \*\*; repeat from \* to \*\* twice more; in next st make corner – 1dc, 1tr, 2ch, 1tr, 1dc; into next 4sts & ch1 sp make the following – [1dc] x 2, [1hdc] x2, 1sc; finish with a sewn bind off.

*15sts on each side, ch2 in each corner*
